



Quezon City Pride Council (QCPC) was constituted to oversee the integration of all city programs and projects for the LGBTs (lesbian, gays, bisexual, and transgender) community. QCPC, created by Mayor Herbert Bautista thru an office order, was formally launched March 25, 2013 to highlight the city government's continuing support for the implementation and enforcement of gender-based policies, programs and activities.

The QC Pride Council is a pioneering initiative of the QC local government and the first of its kind in the country.

#### **OUR VISION**

QCPC envisions Quezon City as the most open and welcoming city that protects and promote the human rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) persons by supporting the LGBT Pride events and other socio-cultural, economic, environmental, educational and spiritual events without prejudice and discrimination.

1. To mobilize LGBT communities, groups, clans, organizations and associations within Quezon City to stage LGBT related events.
2. Encourage LGBT friendly business and investors to invest in Quezon City to the Pink Peso market concept.
